



FACILITIES & SERVICES NOTICE

March 18, 2020

To protect the Public and Township Staff and to help minimize the spread of COVID - 19 virus, all Township facilities, including the Township Office at 87 John Street South in Aylmer, will be closed to public access effective Wednesday, March 18, 2020 until further notice.

While the Township Office will be staffed, there will be no public access to these premises during this time to minimize direct person to person contact.

Meetings with Township Staff, where appropriate, can be set up on a case by case basis and may require a health screening process in keeping with established public health guidelines.

A Drop Box outside of the Township office is available to drop off documents or payments.

In addition, most transactions can be completed using online resources on our website www.malahide.ca or your bank.

Property Taxes, Water/Wastewater bills and Dog Licences can be paid through online banking or phone banking or using the drop box.

Burn Permits and Garbage Bag Tags can be requested by calling the office at 519-773-5344 during regular office hours.

Malahide Community Place (MCP) and the South Dorchester Community Hall (SDCH) are also closed to the public and all municipal and private functions are cancelled until further notice. The Township will issue refunds where applicable for any bookings cancelled on this account.

The County has announced closure of the Springfield Library.
