The Council identified a number of goals to be included in the Strategic Plan. Each councillor was asked to select what they felt were the top three priority issues to be addressed in the strategic plan. Below are the results of this voting with the top priority goal/outcome noted first:

- 1. Maintain and improve roads and infrastructure (7)
- 2. Reduce the East Elgin Community Complex deficit (5)
- 3. Encourage business and residential growth, helping to maintain workforce (4)
- 4. Resolve Port Bruce issues (2)
- 5. Improve villages (2)
- 6. Continue and explore increasing shared services (1)
- 7. Increase use of township facilities
- 8. Encourage young farmers
